

DRAUME version difference

DRAUME has been updated. We received some constructive feedback on v1 which got the ball rolling. Re-evaluating the electronic and algorithms have resulted in a complete internal redesign. The changes and improvements are listed below. Note that v2 is not aimed as a cash-grab towards v1 owners. If you're happy with your v1 these changes probably shouldn't warrant another pedal purchase. If however you found v1 lacking you may find v2 to be a better fit for you.

Improvements:

- Better signal-noise-ratio (SNR).
- Removed artifacts related to FM function (see more on FM below).
- GATE function is stable regardless of CLK setting.
- Better reverb decay stability. Better DC buildup rejection.

Changes:

- Lo/Hi emphasis tone control has been replaced by a 2nd order lowpass filter.
- The AM function has been reworked giving a slightly different flavor.
- The FM function has been redesigned giving a different flavor:
 - The v1 FM function had the drawback of producing distortion artifacts. These may be annoying in some settings, while being unnoticeable in others. The moderately high modulation speed of this function had an interesting timbral effect on the sound.
 - The v2 FM function does not produce the distortion artifacts related with the v1 function. The modulation frequency is a little slower making the timbral effects less pronounced. We decided on the change due to the new FM being better suited in a larger variety of settings.
- HALL has less pre-delay.
- METAL have been replaced by new algorithms with different timbre and behavior.
- GRAIN have been replaced by new algorithms with different timbre and behavior.
- The interface layout is slightly different (parameter placement and LED shape).
